

In October 2005, the City Council approved an ordinance adding a new subsection (c) to Section 80.69.1, and amending Sections 80.76.2 and 89.60 of the Los Angeles Municipal Code, to regulate the parking of unhitched trailers on streets in the City of Los Angeles. The proliferation of these trailers is a distraction to drivers and creates blight in our communities.

Unfortunately, the existing penalty provisions of this ordinance have been shown to be too low to discourage the parking of unhitched trailers on City streets. The penalties should be re-evaluated and substantially increased to effectively deter repeat offenders.

I THEREFORE MOVE that the Council request that the City Attorney prepare and present a revision to the Los Angeles Municipal Code Section 80.69.1 (c) Civil Penalties associated with parking unhitched trailers to increase the penalty amounts to discourage the illegal parking of these vehicles on City streets, including expanded provisions for the towing of these vehicles.
