LOS ANGELES – Responding to community concerns over a recent LAPD report detailing the 20 most dangerous streets in the San Fernando Valley, Councilman Dennis P. Zine is holding a traffic summit to discuss strategies to combat traffic safety issues and to review statistics on injuries and fatalities.

“I was an LAPD Motor Officer, and I have personally witnessed the effects that careless driving can have on people, and it isn’t pretty,” said Zine “I am hopeful that this meeting will allow the community and LAPD to find reasonable ways to reduce injuries, and accidents.”

Two of the main thoroughfares mentioned in the report, Victory Boulevard and Sherman Way, are in the Third Council District, which is represented by Zine.

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
