PADILLA NAMES BILL MABIE AS DISTRICT DIRECTOR

LOS ANGELES – City Council President Alex Padilla today named political veteran Bill Mabie as District Director for the Office of Council District 7.

Mabie worked for State Senator Richard Polanco for 12 years, serving as his chief spokesperson, legislative advisor, transportation and land use deputy, and as the head of his Los Angeles district office.

Mabie, who is fluent in Spanish, has served as President of the Highland Park Chamber of Commerce, is a Board Member of Northeast Trees, and is the Founder and President of Gardens for Kids. Previously, Mabie served in the United States Peace Corps in Honduras and as a Peace Corps recruiter for the southwest region of the United States.

“Bill has extensive professional and community experience throughout Southern California and has a thorough understanding of the issues that matter to our neighborhoods,” said Padilla. “I am proud to have him as a member of my team.”

Mabie will begin his new position on Monday, July 1.
