## PADILLA STATEMENT REGARDING THREE FINALISTS FOR APPOINTMENT TO CHIEF OF POLICE

**LOS ANGELES** – City Council President Alex Padilla today made the following statement regarding today's Police Commission decision on the selection of the next Chief of Police for the City of Los Angeles:

"I would like to commend all of the candidates for Chief of Police who went through a rigorous interview process that has resulted in the three finalists announced today.

"As we conduct further rounds of interviews, we will be seeking a candidate who will be able to tackle some of the most pressing public safety issues facing our City: the recruitment, retention, and morale of LAPD officers; the implementation of increased community-based policing in our neighborhoods; the ability to further the ongoing process of police reform efforts; and the need for a Chief of Police who will provide leadership of a diverse Department in one of the most diverse cities in the world.

"I look forward to participating in the process of selecting a new Chief of Police who will best serve each and every neighborhood within the City of Los Angeles."
