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**PADILLA APPOINTS CHAIRS, MEMBERS OF CITY COUNCIL COMMITTEES**  
*New Committee Structure Reflects a Growing, Changing Los Angeles*

**LOS ANGELES** – City Council President Alex Padilla today announced the appointment of members of the City Council to fifteen standing City Council Committees and four Ad Hoc Committees. A complete list of committee appointments, including Chairs, Vice-Chairs, and Members, is attached.

“The new Los Angeles City Council has a unique opportunity to shape one of the most important cities of the 21<sup>st</sup> century,” said Padilla. “I know that each and every one of my colleagues are committed to serving their constituents and the entire City of Los Angeles. The talent, knowledge, and expertise on the new Council will enable the leadership of this City to begin to tackle the most critical issues we face now and in the years to come. We are eager to roll up our sleeves and get to work on behalf of the residents, businesses, and community groups throughout Los Angeles.”

On July 11, Council President Padilla introduced a resolution to form, restructure and rename select City Council committees. The restructuring and renaming was approved by the Council on July 16.

Under the City Charter, the Council President appoints the members and chairs of each City Council committee. Padilla’s appointments are effective Monday, July 28, 2003.
