MAYOR HAHN ANNOUNCES TWO ADDITIONAL NEIGHBORHOOD COUNCILS
CERTIFIED

#40 South Robertson, #41 Mar Vista

LOS ANGELES - Mayor Jim Hahn today announced that the Board of Neighborhood Commissioners voted unanimously to certify the South Robertson (SoRo) Neighborhood Council (#40) and the Mar Vista Community Council (#41).

"I am glad to see that these two Westside neighborhood councils have taken the necessary steps to complete the certification process so that their voices can be heard in city government," said Mayor Hahn. "The South Robertson area is a wonderfully diverse area, and the leadership has done a great job in involving everyone in their efforts. It is a model for other communities. The Mar Vista Community Council will be a true voice for the community. I look forward to working with both councils."

The neighborhood council certifications took place at Daniel Webster Middle School in West Los Angeles.

"Life begins at 60, but for SoRo life begins at 40. We are honored to be the 40th certified neighborhood council," said SoRo Neighborhood Council President Carole Segal.

"Tonight's actions by the Board of Neighborhood Commissioners represent a major victory for the Westside and the entire system of neighborhood councils. Both SoRo and Mar Vista have already shown a strong commitment to improving the quality of life in their respective neighborhoods," said Board of Neighborhood Commissioner Ron Stone.
