At yesterday's meeting of the Board of Neighborhood Commissioners, there was a discussion about a staff report on overlapping boundaries. Policy and procedural options were discussed.

Some of the specific issues included: insufficient population (areas with less than the 20,000 residents required by ordinance; commercial, employment, and retail nodes, major employers; communities of historical or cultural significance; communities of interest; and competing groups.
