One of the most amazing discoveries has been the tomb of the Egyptian boy king; King Tutankhamun. Explore these rare finds at the Los Angeles County Museum of Art. Over 130 rarely- or never-traveled objects are part of a exhibit of 3,300-to-3,500-year-old artifacts. The last time artifacts from Tut's tomb visited the U.S. was between 1976 and 1979.
