This was done without consultation of the City Council as the Legislative body for the City. In issuing the injunction, Judge Hernan Vera of the Central District Court of California deemed the LAPD action as "unlawful force against members of the media." Since June 2025 at least 60 new liability claims have been filed against LAPD by protesters and journalists for use of force. Feldstein Soto is also asked to present in closed session to the City Council.
