- D. Update on Speed bump: Ramiel Shamwell was reaching out to LADOT regarding a speed bump. Kristen Shubert went to his house and witnessed the large number of cars that ran the stop signs at the intersection of Lurline and Vintage, at Chatsworth High School.

3. New Business:

- A. Motion to approve a Neighborhood Purpose Grant (NPG) of up to \$2,000 to provide completion backpacks for graduates of the just-started CERT training program in Chatsworth.

The grant is requested by Southern California Preparedness Foundation to provide completion kits to the LAFD CERT class taking place in March and April in Chatsworth. The Foundation has partnered on such projects with numerous other neighborhood councils in the Valley to the satisfaction of all involved. In each case, the NC gets a Neighborhood Purposes grant to cover half the estimated cost of course completion backpacks loaded with disaster response supplies for each graduating attendee; our Foundation picks up the other half and covers any overages that may result from price increases or increases in the number of graduates over the original estimate.

The upcoming CERT class is being organized by LAPD Devonshire Division. It will be held on seven consecutive Monday evenings beginning March 2 and ending April 13 at Our Community School, 10045 Jumilla Avenue in Chatsworth. As part of the arrangement, our Foundation also provides professionally made backstage-pass-type ID tags with the NC's name and logo on one side.
