LA's recently completed [Parks Needs Assessment](#) found that LA's parks are chronically underfunded: a \$2.68 billion deferred maintenance backlog, 28% of full-time staff lost since 2008, and just \$92 per capita invested versus a peer-city average of \$283. This increase in funds will go towards hiring new staff to help make the parks safer.
 - b. Presentation by Sarah Friedman from LA Park Funding Advocates.
