AB361 Updates: Public comment cannot be required to be submitted in advance of the meeting, only realtime public comment is required. If there are any broadcasting interruptions that prevent the public from observing or hearing the meeting, the meeting must be recessed or adjourned. If members of the public are unable to provide public comment or be heard due to issues within the Neighborhood Council's control, the meeting must be recessed or adjourned.

- a. Motion (Ravi Sankaran) Approval of Minutes from October 27, 2022 Green Committee meeting.
- b. Motion (Ravi Sankaran) The DRNC Green Committee supports CF 22-1466 to require reporting on the safety risks of the Playa del Rey Gas Storage facility and potential impacts to the community in the event of a leak. In 2015 the largest and most environmentally-damaging methane leak in US history occurred at the Aliso Canyon gas storage facility operated by SoCal Gas Company. If a similar leak were to occur at the Playa del Rey facility it would directly impact the Del Rey community and therefore the risks, impacts, and safety plans need to be thoroughly evaluated.
- c. Motion (Nancy Matson) The DRNC Green Committee supports CF 22-1402 which would require a Municipal Greenhouse Gas Emissions Inventory to be developed and maintained. As Californians, we are at ground zero of the climate crisis, enduring heatwaves and their accompanying unbreathable air, wildfires, and coastal soil erosion which has already shut down our south coast rail line. We need to take action fast and cannot do so without data to know our efforts are working.

If we are to achieve citywide carbon neutrality by 2045, and municipal operations neutrality by 2035, we need accurate data to ensure that we are getting there. Therefore the Del Rey Neighborhood Council supports this motion.
