Our understanding is that The Pond Company originally expertly restored the Lotus Plants at Echo Park Lake in 2013.  - B. The Echo Park Neighborhood Council would like to submit a comment in response to the Draft Environmental Impact Report (EIR) published by AECOM for LA Metro. The Echo Park Neighborhood Council would like to highlight and echo some concerns already raised by the residents of Echo Park, our neighbors and community partners regarding the environmental and cultural impacts of the proposed aerial gondola project from Union Station to Dodger Stadium.
