2. General Public Comment on Non-Agenda Items

3. Selection of Stakeholders to Fill Vacant Seats on the Board

The board has received an application for one vacant seat: One (1) District 5 seat with the term expiring 2023. Bylaws, Art. V, §4.

First, all applicants who have timely submitted applications by the Friday March 24th, 2023, 5:00pm deadline and documented proof of stakeholder status will identify themselves as present.

Second, the Chair may provide a few questions that applicants for the seat may choose to address. The Board will hear from all qualified applicants <u>2 minutes per applicant</u>. There will be public comment regarding the applicants, <u>30 seconds per comment</u>. After which, Board members may make a brief comment/question, <u>up to 30 seconds each</u>. Applicants may be given the opportunity to respond to public and board comments, <u>up to 60 seconds for each applicant</u>.

If there is less than a majority of those present and voting for all applicants, the two applicants with the most votes proceed to a run-off. In the run-off, the applicant with the most votes fills that seat immediately, unless there are more 'no' votes than that applicant has received. If there are more 'no' votes than votes for an applicant, that seat remains vacant until the next regular board meeting, when the process will be repeated.

Note: Above times are guidelines only and may be adjusted by the Chair based on the number of applicants and persons wishing to comment.
