IN CONFORMITY WITH THE JANUARY 1, 2026, ENACTMENT OF CALIFORNIA SENATE BILL 707 (DURAZO) AND LA CITY COUNCIL FILE 23-1114, THE LOS FELIZ NEIGHBORHOOD COUNCIL MEETING WILL BE CONDUCTED VIRTUALLY.

VIEWING MEETING: Members of the public may join the meeting by [1] Going to <https://bit.ly/LFNCGBZoom> and joining via Zoom (Meeting ID: 970 3471 3481 or [2] Calling (669) 900-6833 (Meeting ID: 970 3471 3481 and then pressing # to join the meeting.

PUBLIC COMMENT – Members of the public may submit public comment for any agenda item or on matters not appearing on this Agenda within the Council’s jurisdiction either prior to the meeting or during the period allotted for public comment. Public comment may be submitted by [1] emailing [info@losofeliznc.org](mailto:info@losofeliznc.org), and/or [2] orally at the meeting by clicking the ‘raise hand’ button via Zoom during the period allotted for public comment, or [4] by dialing \*9 (if joining the meeting via telephone) to ‘raise hand’ during the period allotted for public comment. Please note that under the Ralph M. Brown Act (CA Govt Code § 54950), the Board is prevented from acting on a matter brought to its attention during the general public comment period; however, the issue may become the subject of a future Board meeting.

(A) Oral public comment for agenda items is limited to 1 minute per item for a total of 3 minutes. Oral public comment on non-agenda items is limited to 1 minute. Total oral public comment may not exceed 4 minutes per speaker, unless allowed by the chair. Commenters are encouraged but not required to fill out a public comment speaker card prior to speaking.

(B) In the event of a disruption that prevents the eligible legislative body from broadcasting the meeting to members of the public using the call-in option or internet-based service option, or in the event of a disruption within the eligible legislative body’s control that prevents members of the public from offering public comments using the call-in option or internet-based service option, the eligible legislative body shall take no further action on items appearing on the meeting agenda until public access to the meeting via the call-in option or internet-based service option is restored. Actions taken on agenda items during a disruption that prevents the eligible legislative body from broadcasting the meeting may be challenged pursuant to Section 54960.1. California Government Code Section 54953.8(b)(3).

(C) The legislative body shall not require public comments to be submitted in advance of the meeting and shall provide an opportunity for the public to address the legislative body and offer comments in real time. California Government Code Section 54953.8(b)(4).

(D) Notwithstanding Section 54953.3, an individual desiring to provide public comment through the use of an internet website, or other online platform, not under the control of the eligible legislative body, that requires registration to log in to a teleconference may be required to register as required by the third-party internet website or online platform to participate. California Government Code Section 54953.8(b)(5).

(E) A legislative body that provides a timed public comment period for each agenda item shall not close the public comment period for the agenda item, or the opportunity to register, pursuant to paragraph (5), to provide public comment until that timed public comment period has elapsed. California Government Code Section 54953.8(b)(6)(A).

(F) A legislative body that does not provide a timed public comment period, but takes public comment separately on each agenda item, shall allow a reasonable amount of time per agenda item to allow public members the opportunity to provide public comment, including time for members of the public to register pursuant to paragraph (5), or otherwise be recognized for the purpose of providing public comment. California Government Code Section 54953.8(b)(6)(B).
