Topic: Great ShakeOut Thursday October 19th (tomorrow) is our yearly Great Shake Out city-wide earthquake drill.

At 10:19 AM (or when you are available), imagine you are experiencing a huge earthquake.

If you are inside a building: Drop, Cover, and Hold On (under a table).

- After about two minutes (the length of a large earthquake), take your emergency Go Bag (if you have one) and walk outside to an open area away from buildings and wires.
- You would then text family and friends to confirm they are ok.

From Shake Out Team: In an earthquake, you may only have seconds to protect yourself before strong shaking knocks you down, or something falls on you. Practice earthquake-safe actions on October 19. Why? Because when the adrenaline kicks in, you may not act safely if you haven't practiced the Drop, Cover, Hold On drill before that moment. Don't wait until the shaking – register at ShakeOut.org/register to practice earthquake safety with your community.

Invite everyone who matters to you to register and ShakeOut this year— on 10/19 or whatever day works.. Everyone is welcome to participate - individuals, families, businesses, schools, government agencies and organizations!
