IN CONFORMITY WITH THE JANUARY 1, 2026 ENACTMENT OF CALIFORNIA SENATE BILL 707 (DURAZO) AND LA CITY COUNCIL FILE 23-1114, THE NORTH WESTWOOD NEIGHBORHOOD COUNCIL MEETING WILL BE CONDUCTED VIRTUALLY AND IN PERSON.

Public Input at Neighborhood Council Meetings: Public comment may be made on any agenda item, before the Board takes an action on an item, and on other matters not appearing on the agenda that are within the Board's jurisdiction, heard during the general public comment period. Please note that under the Brown Act, the Board is prevented from acting on a

matter that you bring to its attention during the general public comment period; however, the issue raised by a member of the public may become the subject of a future Board meeting. Public comment is limited to two minutes per speaker, unless adjusted by the presiding officer of the Board.

Public comment may be made in any of the following ways: 1) by commenting orally in person at the meeting, 2) by submitting written comment beforehand to <sailasya.nwwnc@gmail.com> (with “Public Comment” and the agenda item number in the subject line), or 3) by commenting via teleconferencing. For comments made via teleconferencing, the public is requested dial *9 or use the “raise hand” option when prompted by the presiding officer to address the Board. Instructions on how to sign up for public comment will be given to attendees at the start of the meeting.

In the event of a disruption that prevents the eligible legislative body from broadcasting the meeting to members of the public using the call-in option or internet-based service option, or in the event of a disruption within the eligible legislative body’s control that prevents members of the public from offering public comments using the call-in option or internet-based service option, the eligible legislative body shall take no further action on items appearing on the meeting agenda until public access to the meeting via the call-in option or internet-based service option is restored. Actions taken on agenda items during a disruption that prevents the eligible legislative body from broadcasting the meeting may be challenged pursuant to Section 54960.1. **California Government Code Section 54953.8(b)(3).**

Notwithstanding Section 54953.3, an individual desiring to provide public comment through the use of an internet website, or other online platform, not under the control of the eligible legislative body, that requires registration to log in to a teleconference may be required to register as required by the third-party internet website or online platform to participate. **California Government Code Section 54953.8(b)(5),**

A legislative body that provides a timed public comment period for each agenda item shall not close the public comment period for the agenda item, or the opportunity to register, pursuant to paragraph (5), to provide public comment until that timed public comment period has elapsed.

California Government Code Section 54953.8(b)(6)(A),

A legislative body that does not provide a timed public comment period, but takes public comment separately on each agenda item, shall allow a reasonable amount of time per agenda item to allow public members the opportunity to provide public comment, including time for members of the public to register pursuant to paragraph (5), or otherwise be recognized for the purpose of providing public comment.

California Government Code Section 54953.8(b)(6)(B).

Consent Calendar: Every item on the consent calendar will be considered bundled and will be voted on as a single item towards the close of the meeting. Items initially placed on the consent calendar will be marked with an asterisk (*) and red text on the agenda. If a member of the public wishes to make public comment on an item initially placed on the consent calendar, they must do so during the agenda item “Initial Public Comment on Agenda Items,” as there will not be an opportunity for separate comment before the vote on the consent calendar. If a Board Member has an objection to an item being on the consent calendar, they plan to vote against it, or they will need to recuse themselves from consideration of it, they will need to raise that objection during the agenda item “Review and Possible Removal of Items from the Consent Calendar” and ask to have that item or items considered separately. There will be no discussion or comment on the substance of any item on the consent calendar unless it is removed from the consent calendar. An item not initially placed on the consent calendar and not marked on the agenda as such may be added to the consent calendar without objection when it is reached on the agenda and opportunity for public comment is given.

Article V, Section 6, Subsection G of the bylaws: Should no Stakeholder apply to fill a vacancy after appropriate outreach is done, the vacancy procedure in the bylaws is followed, and at least one regular Board meeting has occurred after the outreach period, the vacancy shall be reopened, re-advertised, and filled per the procedure above as an At-large Seat, except if doing so would cause a single Stakeholder group to hold a majority of Board seats. Any Stakeholder eligible for an At-large Seat may apply and serve. The next Board term or the next time the seat becomes vacant, however, the seat shall revert to its original eligibility criteria.
