PUBLIC INPUT AT NEIGHBORHOOD COUNCIL MEETINGS: The public is requested to use Zoom's "Raise Hand" option or dial *9, when prompted by the presiding officer, to address the Board on any agenda item before the Board takes an action on an item. Comments from the public on agenda items will be heard only when the respective item is being considered. Comments from the public on matters not appearing on the agenda that are within the Board's jurisdiction will be heard during the General Public Comment period.

AB 361 Updates:

- Public comment cannot be required to be submitted in advance of the meeting, only real-time public comment is required.
- If there are any broadcasting interruptions that prevent the general public from observing or hearing the meeting, the meeting must be recessed or adjourned.
- If members of the public are unable to provide public comment or be heard due to issues within the Neighborhood Council's control, the meeting must be recessed or adjourned.

Any messaging or virtual background is in the control of the individual board member in their personal capacity and does not reflect any formal position of the NWSPNC or the City of Los Angeles.
