Comments from the public on agenda items will be heard only when the respective item is being considered. Comments from the public on matters not appearing on the agenda that are within the Board's jurisdiction will be heard during the General Public Comment period.

AB 361 Updates:

- Public comment cannot be required to be submitted in advance of the meeting; only real-time public comment is required.
- If there are any broadcasting interruptions that prevent the general public from observing or hearing the meeting, the meeting must be recessed or adjourned.
- If members of the public are unable to provide public comment or be heard due to issues within the Neighborhood Council's control, the meeting must be recessed or adjourned.

Any messaging or virtual background is in the control of the individual board member in their personal capacity and does not reflect any formal position of the NWSPNC or the City of Los Angeles.

Sec. 907. Early Warning System. The Regulations shall establish procedures for receiving input from neighborhood councils prior to decisions by the City Council, City Council Committees and boards and commissions. The procedures shall include, but need not be limited to, notice to neighborhood councils as soon as practical, and a reasonable opportunity to provide input before decisions are made. Notices to be provided include matters to be considered by the City Council, City Council Committees, and City boards or commissions.

 - 1) Port Projects meriting CIS. (Phillips 76, Fish Market, Nederlander Concert Venue, etc.)
 - 2) Astroturf in city parks.
