In conformity with the 1 January 2026 enactment of California Senate Bill SB 707 (Durazo) and L.A. City Council File 23-1114, this Northwest San Pedro Neighborhood Council meeting will be conducted virtually. Every person wishing to address the NWSPNC must join the meeting via one of the methods shown above. Instructions on how to provide public comment will be given to listeners at the start of the meeting.

PUBLIC INPUT AT NEIGHBORHOOD COUNCIL MEETINGS: The public is requested to use Zoom’s “Raise Hand” option or dial *9, when prompted by the presiding officer, to address the Committee on any agenda item before the Committee takes an action on an item. Comments from the public on agenda items will be heard only (no discussion) when the respective item is being considered. Comments from the public on matters not appearing on the agenda that are within the Committee’s jurisdiction will be heard during the General Public Comment period.

SB 707 Updates:

54953.8(b)(3) In the event of a disruption that prevents the legislative body [NWSPNC] from broadcasting the meeting to members of the public using the call-in option or internet-based service option, or in the event of a disruption within the local agency’s control that prevents members of the public from offering public comments using the call-in option or internet-based service option, the legislative body shall take no further action on items appearing on the meeting agenda until public access to the meeting via the call-in option or internet-based service option is restored. Actions taken on agenda items during a disruption that prevents the legislative body from broadcasting the meeting may be challenged pursuant to Section 54960.1.

(4) The legislative body shall not require public comments to be submitted in advance of the meeting and must provide an opportunity for the public to address the legislative body and offer comment in real time.

(5) Notwithstanding Section 54953.3, an individual desiring to provide public comment through the use of an internet website, or other online platform, not under the control of the local legislative body, that requires registration to log in to a teleconference may be required to register as required by the third-party internet website or online platform to participate.

(6) (A) A legislative body that provides a timed public comment period for each agenda item shall not close the public comment period for the agenda item, or the opportunity to register, pursuant to paragraph (5), to provide public comment until that timed public comment period has elapsed.

(B) A legislative body that does not provide a timed public comment period, but takes public comment separately on each agenda item, shall allow a reasonable amount of time per agenda item to allow public members the opportunity to provide public comment, including time for members of the public to register pursuant to paragraph (5), or otherwise be recognized for the purpose of providing public comment.

(C) A legislative body that provides a timed general public comment period that does not correspond to a specific agenda item shall not close the public comment period or the opportunity to register, pursuant to paragraph (5), until the timed general public comment period has elapsed.

The presiding officer may establish a maximum length of time for all speakers as needed. *All speakers should remain muted until recognized by the presiding officer and mute themselves when their speaking time has ended.* The public is requested to dial *9 if on the telephone, or use the “Raise Hand” option if on a computer, when prompted by the presiding officer to address the Committee on any non-agenda item(s). When recognized to speak, each speaker is requested to state their first and last name for the record.
