IN CONFORMITY WITH THE JANUARY 1, 2026 ENACTMENT OF CALIFORNIA SENATE BILL 707 (DURAZO) AND LA CITY COUNCIL FILE 23-1114, THE NORTHWEST SAN PEDRO, CENTRAL SAN PEDRO, AND COASTAL SAN PEDRO NEIGHBORHOOD COUNCIL JOINT PLANNING AND LAND USE COMMITTEE MEETING WILL BE CONDUCTED VIRTUALLY and IN PERSON.

Every person wishing to address the Committee must dial (669) 900-6833 or Toll Free (833) 548-0282, enter Webinar ID: 890 9551 2946, and then press # to join the meeting. When prompted by the presiding officer, to provide public input at the Committee meeting the public will be requested to dial *9 or use the Raise Hand option, to address the Committee on any agenda item before the Committee takes action on an item. Comments from the public on agenda items will be heard only when the respective item is being considered.

Comments from the public on other matters not appearing on the agenda that are within the Committee's jurisdiction will be heard during the General Public Comment period. Please note that under the Brown Act, the Committee is prevented from acting on a matter brought to its attention during the General Public Comment period; however, the issue raised by a member of the public may become the subject of a future Committee meeting. Public comment is limited to two (2) minutes per speaker, unless adjusted by the presiding officer.

In the event of a disruption that prevents the eligible legislative body from broadcasting the meeting to members of the public using the call-in option or internet-based service option, or in the event of a disruption within the eligible legislative body's control that prevents members of the public from offering public comments using the call-in option or internet-based service option, the eligible legislative body shall take no further action on items appearing on the meeting agenda until public access is restored. Actions taken on agenda items during a disruption may be challenged pursuant to Section 54960.1. **California Government Code Section 54953.8(b)(3).**

The legislative body shall not require public comments to be submitted in advance of the meeting and shall provide an opportunity for the public to address the legislative body and offer comments in real time. **California Government Code Section 54953.8(b)(4).**

Notwithstanding Section 54953.3, an individual desiring to provide public comment through the use of an internet website or other online platform not under the control of the eligible legislative body that requires registration to log in to a teleconference may be required to register as required by the third-party platform.

California Government Code Section 54953.8(b)(5).

A legislative body that provides a timed public comment period for each agenda item shall not close the public comment period for the agenda item until that timed public comment period has elapsed.

California Government Code Section 54953.8(b)(6)(A).

A legislative body that does not provide a timed public comment period but takes public comment separately on each agenda item shall allow a reasonable amount of time per agenda item to allow public members the opportunity to provide public comment.

California Government Code Section 54953.8(b)(6)(B).
