General Public Comment – As noted in the meeting Agenda, there is an item dedicated to Public Comment on Items not on the Agenda, but within the purview of the Board. Public comment is limited to two minutes per speaker, unless adjusted by the presiding officer at his or her discretion.

If there are any broadcasting interruptions that prevent the public from observing or hearing the meeting, the meeting must be recessed or adjourned.

If members of the public are unable to provide public comment or be heard due to issues within the Neighborhood Council's control, the meeting must be recessed or adjourned.

Material Provided During the Meeting – In some instances, invited speakers may bring material with them to be provided to the Board during the meeting. With online meetings, this material will likely be sent to the Board as an email attachment so it can be presented and displayed during the online meeting. Materials provided to the Board no less than two hours of the meeting will be emailed to all those who request them before the meeting begins. Material provided to the Board within less than two hours of the start of the meeting will be emailed to those who requested them after the meeting. All materials presented during the meeting will be included with the meeting minutes, which are then posted on the PRNC meetings page.
