**PUBLIC INPUT AT NEIGHBORHOOD COUNCIL MEETINGS** — In conformity with the January 1, 2026 enactment of California Senate Bill 707 (Durazo), L.A. City Council File 23-114, and the Ralph M. Brown Act, California Code Section 54953.8 (SB 411 Portantino), and City of Los Angeles Council File 23-114 approval on November 1, 2023, this meeting of the Coastal San Pedro Neighborhood Council will be conducted virtually. Every person wishing to address the legislative body must dial (669) 900-6833, and enter 859 8030 9443 and then press # to join the meeting. When prompted by the presiding officer to provide public input at the Neighborhood Council meeting, the public will be requested to dial \*9 or use the Raise Hand option to address the legislative body on any agenda item before the legislative body takes an action on an item. Comments from the public on agenda items will be heard only when the respective item is being considered.

Comments from the public on other matters not appearing on the agenda that are within the assembly's jurisdiction will be heard during the General Public Comment period. Please note that under the Brown Act, the assembly is prevented from acting on a matter that you bring to its attention during the General Public Comment period; however, the issue raised by a member of the public may become the subject of a future legislative body meeting. Public comment may be limited to a fixed time per speaker or a limited number of speakers by the presiding officer of the assembly. Those wishing to make comment, but not wanting to speak publicly, may submit written communications.

This Agenda Meeting is advisory in nature to the Coastal San Pedro Neighborhood Council Governing Board. Any decisions made at this meeting are not considered to be Governing Board actions, unless this meeting is given the power to act on an item by the Board, and shall go forward as recommendations to the Governing Board for a final vote at a regular or special Governing Board meeting. A quorum of the Governing Board members may be present. Stakeholders and Governing Board members present at the meeting may suggest items for the Governing Board agenda. All Governing Board members and committee chairs (or committee vice- chairs in the committee chair's absence) present at the meeting may vote on placing items on the agenda.

**STATE OF CALIFORNIA PENAL CODE SECTION 403** (Amended by Stats. 1994, Ch. 923, Sec. 159. Effective January 1, 1995.) — Every person who, without authority of law, willfully disturbs or breaks up any assembly or meeting that is not unlawful in its character, other than an assembly or meeting referred to in Section 302 of the Penal Code or Section 18340 of the Elections Code, is guilty of a misdemeanor.

**TELECONFERENCING CONSIDERATIONS** — In the event of a disruption that prevents the eligible legislative body from broadcasting the meeting to members of the public using the call-in option or internet-based service option, or in the event of a disruption within the eligible legislative body's control that prevents members of the public from offering public comments using the call-in option or internet-based service option, the eligible legislative body shall take no further action on items appearing on the meeting agenda until public access to the meeting via the call-in option or internet-based service option is restored. Actions taken on agenda items during a disruption that prevents the eligible legislative body from broadcasting the meeting may be challenged pursuant to Section 54960.1. *California Government Code Section 54953.8(b)(3)*.

The legislative body shall not require public comments to be submitted in advance of the meeting and shall provide an opportunity for the public to address the legislative body and offer comments in real time. *California Government Code Section 54953.8(b)(4)*.

Notwithstanding Section 54953.3, an individual desiring to provide public comment through the use of an internet website, or other online platform, not under the control of the eligible legislative body, that requires registration to log in to a teleconference may be required to register as required by the third-party internet website or online platform to participate. *California Government Code Section 54953.8(b)(5)*.

A legislative body that provides a timed public comment period for each agenda item shall not close the public comment period for the agenda item, or the opportunity to register, pursuant to paragraph (5), to provide public comment until that timed public comment period has elapsed. *California Government Code Section 54953.8(b)(6)(A)*.

A legislative body that does not provide a timed public comment period, but takes public comment separately on each agenda item, shall allow a reasonable amount of time per agenda item to allow public members the opportunity to provide public comment, including time for members of the public to register pursuant to paragraph (5), or otherwise be recognized for the purpose of providing public comment. *California Government Code Section 54953.8(b)(6)(B)*.
