 - 4.1 Approve up to \$1,000.00 for sound system for use at GTLNC public meetings to include 8 microphones, 2 receivers, a 3-year warranty, taxes and shipping.
 - 4.2 Approve up to \$3,000.00 for GTLNC Public Safety Event to take place at North Weddington Park Recreation Center on a Saturday, September 6th, 2025 to benefit residents and stakeholders of Greater Toluca Lake, demonstrate the MyLA311 service and app, and teach how to use MyLA311 to improve our community. Funds will purchase GTLNC-themed gift bags, flyers to promote event (design and printing), snacks, beverages, ice, napkins, plates, plastic cutlery, trash bags and incidentals. Rentals to include rectangular tables, linens, and include set-up and pick-up, and any permits and/or insurance required by the City of Los Angeles. NOTE: this item was previously approved by GTLNC on February 18th, 2025 for up to \$5,000.00 and amended on Tuesday March 18th, 2025 when this event was originally scheduled to take place on June 7th, 2025.
 - 4.3 Approve up to \$750.00 for up to three (3) "Coffee With A Cop" events once per calendar quarter alternating through three (3) remaining neighborhoods of Greater Toluca Lake (i.e., Toluca Woods, Toluca Terrace and West Toluca Lake). Such funds will purchase snacks, beverages, napkins, plates, plastic cutlery, trash bags, incidentals, etc. **NOTE**: this item was previously approved on June 18th, 2024 by GTLNC for four (4) events, one of which has taken place in Toluca Lake at Red Maple Café.
 - 4.4 Approve up to \$2,000.00 in support of various free community events open to the public and benefitting stakeholders of Greater Toluca Lake, at which GTLNC is invited to table. Such funds will purchase GTLNC outreach flyers (design and printing), promotional items with GTLNC logo, snacks, related supplies, bottled water or other beverages, ice, condiments, napkins, plates, plastic cutlery, trash bags and incidentals.
 - 4.5 Approve up to \$50.00 for printer ink.

There will be no discussion or comment on the substance of any item unless it is removed from the Consent Calendar. Removed items will be moved to end of the agenda for consideration, or earlier within discretion of Chair.

In conformity with the October 6, 2023 enactment of California Senate Bill 411 (Portantino) and LA City Council approval on November 1, 2023, the Greater Toluca Lake Neighborhood Council meeting will be conducted virtually.

Every person wishing to address the Board must dial (+1-669-900-6833 then enter Meeting ID: 892 9600 9857 and press # to join the meeting. When prompted by the presiding officer, to provide public input at the Neighborhood Council meeting the public will be requested to dial *9 or use the Raise Hand option, to address the Board on any agenda item before the Board takes an action on an item. Comments from the public on agenda items will be heard only when the respective item is being considered. Comments from the public on other matters not appearing on the agenda that are within the Board's jurisdiction will be heard during the General Public Comment period. Please note that under the Brown Act, the Board is prevented from acting on a matter that you bring to its attention during the General Public Comment period; however, the issue raised by a member of the public may become the subject of a future Board meeting. Public comment is limited to two (2) minutes per speaker, unless adjusted by the presiding officer of the Board.

SB 411 Updates:

In the event of a disruption that prevents the eligible legislative body from broadcasting the meeting to members of the public using the call-in option or internet-based service option, or in the event of a disruption within the eligible legislative body's control that prevents members of the public from offering public comments using the call-in option or internet-based service option, the eligible legislative body shall take no further action on items appearing on the meeting agenda until public access to the meeting via the call-in option or internet-based service option is restored. Actions taken on agenda items during a disruption that prevents the eligible legislative body from broadcasting the meeting may be challenged pursuant to Section 54960.1.

- (C) The eligible legislative body shall not require public comments to be submitted in advance of the meeting and shall provide an opportunity for the public to address the legislative body and offer comments in real time.
- (D) Notwithstanding Section 54953.3, an individual desiring to provide public comment through the use of an internet website, or other online platform, not under the control of the eligible legislative body, that requires registration to log in to a teleconference may be required to register as required by the third-party internet website or online platform to participate.
- (E) (i) An eligible legislative body that provides a timed public comment period for each agenda item shall not close the public comment period for the agenda item, or the opportunity to register, pursuant to subparagraph (D), to provide public comment until that timed public comment period has elapsed.
- (ii) An eligible legislative body that does not provide a timed public comment period, but takes public comment separately on each agenda item, shall allow a reasonable amount of time per agenda item to allow public members the opportunity to provide public comment, including time for members of the public to register pursuant to subparagraph (D), or otherwise be recognized for the purpose of providing public comment.
- (iii) An eligible legislative body that provides a timed general public comment period that does not correspond to a specific agenda item shall not close the public comment period or the opportunity to register, pursuant to subparagraph (D), until the timed general public comment period has elapsed.
