The Committee passed the following motion:

The PLUM Committee opposes any density building in single-family zones because of these factors:

1. Increase in density greatly increases changes of urban conflagrations. [See January 7, 2025.]
2. The law currently allows developers to substantially increase density in single family zones without improving or upgrading existing infrastructure.
3. These density increases bypass any safety, traffic, environmental or quality-of-life realities.

We recommend the Full GTLNC Board consider opposing the same. Vote was unanimous.”
