The grant is for our Humane Education Learning Program (HELP), an interactive and service-oriented program to meet the needs of homeless animals. Eileen and her certified therapy dog Molly teaches: nursery to high schoolaged youth. Our HELP lessons help raise awareness of the plight of shelter animals. These lessons have been proven to be a long-term solution to pet abuse, neglect and abandonment.
