As of now, that is a 2/3 majority of Board seats (17 yes votes for the WHNC to take action). That is being contested by the Valley Alliance of Neighborhood Councils (VANC).

One proposal is to require Board meetings to be held in public, with a possible consideration to allow Board members to participate remotely in a maximum of two meetings per calendar year.

Another proposal lets committee chairs determine whether to meet in public or virtually.

Under current procedures, hybrid meetings for the public are allowed and up to the discretion of committee chairs.

Board meetings currently have a hybrid component for the public.

This will undoubtedly be a complex discussion. All opinions are valued; please treat one and another with respect.

The next meeting of this committee is scheduled on Tuesday, December 26, 2023, at 7:30 PM. This meeting is subject to cancellation. **Public Input:** Comments from the public on agenda items will be heard only when the respective item is being considered. Comments from the public on other matters not appearing on the agenda that are within the Board's jurisdiction will be heard during the General Public Comment period. Please note that under the Brown Act, the Board is prevented from acting on a matter that you bring to its attention during the General Public Comment period; however, an issue raised by a member of the public may become the subject of a future Board meeting. Public comment is limited to two minutes per speaker, unless adjusted by the presiding officer of the committee.
