Subject: RECOMMEND APPROVAL OF THE APPLICATION OF BELLA VITA HOME HEALTH INC.

FOR ONE UNRESTRICTED NON-AMBULATORY PASSENGER VEHICLE PERMIT

RECOMMENDATIONS

That your Board:

- a. **Find** that Bella Vita Home Health Inc. based upon evidence of patients in need of transportation; public convenience and necessity, requires the operation of one unrestricted non-ambulatory passenger vehicle.
- b. **Grant** one unrestricted non-ambulatory passenger vehicle permit to Bella Vita Home Health Inc. contingent upon:
 - 1. The applicant filing with the Department in such form as the Department requires and thereafter, keeping in full force and effect a policy of automobile liability insurance acceptable to the City Attorney and the City Risk Manager;
 - 2. The drivers and attendants obtaining the required permits;
 - 3. The applicant obtaining commercial or exempt registration for the vehicles;
 - 4. The vehicles passing Department inspection;
 - 5. The applicant complying with all Board rules and regulations and City ordinances pertaining to the operation of non-ambulatory passenger vehicles;
 - 6. The applicant charging only those rates for non-ambulatory passenger vehicle service as set forth in Board Order No. 608 (Ordinance No. 187587) and successor regulations; and
 - 7. The vehicles must be placed into service within 120 days after the Board of Transportation Commissioners' (Board) approval, or such authority shall become invalid. Upon written request and for good cause, the Department in its discretion, may grant an extension of time beyond the initial 120-day period after Board approval. Any request for an extension beyond the initial deadline date must be received prior to the 120-day deadline. Furthermore, if an extension is granted, only one extension may be allowed per application.

INITIATED BY

On June 5, 2023, the Department received an application from Behrokh Tabibian, Owner of Bella Vita Home Health Inc., 12125 Vanowen Street, Suite 1, North Hollywood, California 91605, requesting for one unrestricted non-ambulatory passenger vehicle permit for gurney van services (Attachment 1). On November 8, 2023, the Department received the last document needed to complete the application. On December 14, 2023, the background check document was cleared to proceed with the application process.

DISCUSSION

Bella Vita Home Health Inc. is not currently authorized by the Board to operate any vehicles for hire in the City of Los Angeles.

The history of Bella Vita Home Health Inc.'s business is as follows: On July 9, 2019, the Articles of Incorporation of a General Stock Corporation were filed with the California Secretary of State establishing Bella Vita Home Health Inc. (Attachment 2). On August 28, 2023, the Statement of Information was filed with the California Secretary of State naming Behrokh Tabibian as the Chief Executive Officer, Chief Financial Officer, Secretary, and Farzaneh Tabibian as the Director of the company (Attachment 3). Behrokh Tabibian is the sole shareholder of the company.

Public Convenience and Necessity

The application of Bella Vita Home Health Inc. was evaluated against Section 2 of the Guidelines for Establishing Public Convenience and Necessity as established by the Board on August 11, 2005, for applicants with no unrestricted non-ambulatory passenger vehicle permits (Attachment 4).

- a. <u>Experience</u> The applicant submitted the resume of Mr. Behrokh Tabibian, Representative of Merz Construction from January 2019 to February 2022. His resume states that he was responsible for managing transportation fleet operations of two to five vehicles daily, planning and scheduling of all transportation, and handling customer complaints.
- b. <u>Background Check</u> The background check was conducted on the owner and operation manager of Bella Vita Home Health Inc. and no disqualifying criminal history was found as listed in Board Order No. 600.
- c. <u>Financial Capability</u> The applicant submitted financial documentation showing that the company demonstrates sufficient liquid assets to support the request for one non-ambulatory passenger vehicle permit.
- d. <u>Hours of Operation</u> The regular hours of operation for transportation service are 24 hours a day, seven days a week.

There is no documented evidence of illegal operation by Bella Vita Home Health Inc. in the City of Los Angeles in the past 12 months.
