Subject: **FINAL APPROVAL OF BOARD ORDER 611 RE: 2024-25 PRIVATE AMBULANCE SERVICE RATE ADJUSTMENT AND ADOPTION OF NEW METHODOLOGY FOR FUTURE ADJUSTMENTS**

That the Board of Transportation Commissioners (Commission):

1. **Approve** Final Board Order 611.
2. **Rescind** Board Order 609 and **adopt** the attached Board Order 611 establishing the above rates and charges for private ambulance service in the City of Los Angeles; and
2. **Instruct** the Commission Executive Assistant to forward the attached draft rate ordinance approving the Resolution designated as Board Order 611 to the Mayor for approval by the City Council and Mayor.

DISCUSSION

On June 13, 2024, staff appeared before the Commission to discuss and support a rate adjustment for the Ambulance industry, (See attached Board Report.) At that meeting, staff discussed the proposed option which included increasing the current rate schedule as noted in the Board Order 611, as well as aligning future adjustments based on the percentage change for Los Angeles County Ambulance rates.

During the period since the June Commission meeting, staff had discussions and received input from various stakeholders including the ambulance and hospital industries and determined that the LADOT will continue to regulate rates and move forward with Board Order 611 as written.

FISCAL IMPACT STATEMENT

These changes will not result in fiscal impacts to the City of Los Angeles.
