All public comment will be heard at the beginning of the meeting and will be limited to two (2) minutes per individual. Time cannot be ceded to another speaker, and an individual may speak only once during the public comment period. The chair may manage the meeting and the public comment time allotted in consultation with the City Attorney.
