AGENDA BOARD OF FIRE COMMISSIONERS SPECIAL MEETING

Tuesday, June 7, 2022 at 9:00 a.m.

In accordance with Government Code Section 54953, subsections (e)(1) and (e)(3), and in light of the State of Emergency originally proclaimed by the Governor on March 4, 2020 relating to COVID-19 and ongoing concerns that meeting in person would present imminent risks to the health or safety of attendees and/or that the State of Emergency continues to directly impact the ability of members to meet safely in person, the June 7, 2022, meeting of the Board of Fire Commissioners will be conducted entirely via Zoom Webinar teleconference, and telephonically. The meeting will **not** be conducted at the Fire Commission Meeting Room, City Hall East, Room 1820, 200 North Main Street – 18th Floor, Los Angeles, CA 90012.

Members of the public are invited to address the Board of Fire Commissioners on any item on the agenda and on any matter within the subject matter jurisdiction of the Board during the public comment section. All public comment will be heard at the beginning of the meeting and will be limited to one (1) minute per agenda item, up to two (2) minutes total. At the request of the speaker, the speaker will be afforded an additional (1) minute for general public comment, for a maximum of three (3) minutes per speaker. Time cannot be ceded to another speaker, and an individual may speak only once during the public comment period. Only those who are in the queue when the chair begins the public comment period will be allowed to speak. The chair may manage the meeting and the public comment time allotted in consultation with the City Attorney.

You may also listen to the meeting live and give public comment via telephone. Public participants should dial the phone number 1 (669) 900-9128.

Public participants will be asked for a Meeting ID, and should enter 881 2091 3045, followed by the # (pound sign). Participants press # (pound sign) again to continue.

Participants will then be joined into the meeting.

To raise your hand on this phone call to give Public Comment, press *9.

CONSENT ITEMS - Designed to minimize the meeting time relative to routine matters, the documentation provided to the Board for these items contains sufficient information for approval without inquiry or discussion. The President will call for a vote on the Consent Agenda as a whole. The Board's vote will be treated as separate votes for each item considered. Any item may be moved to the Regular Agenda for discussion at the request of a Board member or if a member of the general public submits a request to speak on the subject matter.

DISPOSITION OF ITEMS - Actions of the Board shall become final at the expiration of the next five (5) meeting days of the City Council during which the Council has convened in regular session, unless the Council acts within that time by two-thirds vote to bring the action before it or to waive review of the action.
