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### SUMMARY

The Los Angeles City Council District 10 and the First-In Fire Foundation have graciously donated funds to purchase a commercial-grade freezer for Fire Station 68 in Operations South Bureau. The purpose of the equipment is to provide a reliable freezer that allows LAFD members to properly store more food for all three shifts, which can reduce time at the grocery store for members. The extra storage will also allow members to stock up and be prepared ahead of emergency calls. The value of this donation is estimated at \$744.59

Submitted in accordance with the Los Angeles Administrative Code, Article 12, Sections 5.111.3 and 5.111.4, which provides for the receipt of gifts and bequests of personal property to be utilized by the Fire Department, not exceeding \$5000.00 in market value shall be submitted to the Board of Fire Commissioners for acceptance or rejection.

SUMMARY

The LA City Council District 10 in partnership with the First-In Fire Foundation have given grant funds to Fire Station 68 to use to purchase a freezer. The commanders of Fire Station 68 are respectfully requesting that the Board of Fire Commissioners approve the grant to be used for Fire Station 68.

RECOMMENDATION

It is respectfully recommended that the Board of Fire Commissioners approve the request to accept the donation of the freezer.

FINDINGS

Fire Station 68 is one of the busiest stations in Battalion 18. As a result, time is extremely valuable to the members of this fire station who attempt to carry out their station duties between calls. Having a reliable freezer allows for more food storage for all three shifts which can reduce time at the grocery store for our members. This also allows members to stock up and be prepared way ahead of emergencies.

The freezer identified is a FRG brand 13 cu. Ft. upright freezer, model #FFFU13F2VW. The total cost of the grant for Fire Station 68 is \$744.59 (see attached invoice).

The members of Fire Station 68 respectfully request approval to accept funds donated from the Office of LA City Council District 10 in partnership with First-In Fire Foundation to purchase a freezer.

Fire Station 68 is a very busy station. In 2021, Engine 68 was the 10<sup>th</sup> busiest engine in the City of Los Angeles. Rescue 68 was the 33<sup>th</sup> busiest in the City. Having a reliable freezer allows for more food storage for all three shifts and can reduce time at the grocery store.


CONCLUSION
