SUMMARY

The Los Angeles Fire Department Foundation (LAFDF) has graciously four (4) LUCAS Devices to the Emergency Medical Services Bureau. The Devices will be deployed to Advanced Provider Response Units 7, 82, 65, and 58. Performing high-quality non-interrupted chest compressions during out-of-hospital cardiac arrest has been shown to double or triple the odds of survival. Effective chest compressions during CPR keep the brain and other vital organs alive longer increasing the chances of survivability. Maintaining high-quality CPR for prolonged periods is a daunting task even for experienced EMS personnel. The LUCAS device's device does more than just provide consistent high-quality CPR. By automating CPR, the LUCAS device improves chest compression quality and supports life-saving circulation during prolonged resuscitation attempts. Its ease of use and operational reliability decreases interruptions in CPR and enhances life-sustaining perfusion to the heart and brain. Advancing EMS care by increasing the accessibility of the LUCAS will provide the citizens of Los Angeles with a device that offers a greater chance of survival, returning to a high-quality life, and most of all; hope. The value of this donation is estimated at \$71,999.56.

RECOMMENDATIONS

That the Board:

1. Receive this report for the In-Kind Donation by the Los Angeles Fire Department Foundation for the items listed above, valued at \$71,999.56 to the Los Angeles Fire Department.
2. Request the Commission Executive Assistant to transmit this report to the Mayor's Office in accordance with Executive Directive No. 3 and to City Council in accordance with the Los Angeles Administrative Code, Ordinance 15514, Article 12, Section 5.111.4, for consideration and approval.

FISCAL IMPACT

There is no fiscal impact on the Department's budget from the acceptance of this donation. Donations provide the necessary items to meet the needs of the respective fire stations or administration sections. Replacement or repair of items meeting City specifications and Fire Department business needs may be borne by General Fund, subject to budgetary constraints.
