





PUBLIC ACCESS DEFIBRILLATOR PROGRAM

- The Mayor, with the unanimous approval of the City Council, created the City's Public Access Defibrillator (PAD) Program in 2000.
- The PAD Program is "to install and maintain AEDs in City Facilities that are utilized by the public for business and recreation and provide training in the use of AEDs and in CPR to City Employees".
- There are no County, State, or Federal mandates requiring cities to have a PAD Program. At the time that the PAD Program was created, Los Angeles was at the forefront in providing these potentially life-saving devices within its City facilities.
