SUMMARY

The Los Angeles City Fire Department Foundation (LAFDF) has graciously donated a new refrigerator to Fire Station 18 located in Granada Hills. The purpose of this equipment is to replace the broken and outdated unit. Members have been responding to emergencies, including brush fires during record high temperatures and “extreme heat warnings”. Having proper nourishment and hydration is not just a matter of comfort, it is essential for their safety and performance. The value of the donation is \$5,733.00.

Donations provide the necessary items to meet the needs of the respective fire stations or administration sections. Replacement or repair of items meeting City specifications and Fire Department business needs may be borne by General Fund, subject to budgetary constraints.
