## **SUMMARY**

This report recommends the Board of Fire Commissioners approval to execute an Agreement with GRM Information Management Services of California, LLC for document scanning and file indexing. The City does not employ sufficient personnel with the required expertise, and it is more economical to have the work performed by a contractor on an as needed basis. The Department, therefore, seeks the services of GRM Information Management Services of California, LLC, who possess the requisite skills, technologies, and proficiencies in these areas. The proposed Agreement is attached for review.

#### RECOMMENDATIONS

That the Board:

- 1. Authorize the Fire Chief to execute the proposed Agreement with GRM Information Management Services of California, LLC, subject to approval of the Mayor, and of the City Attorney as to form.
- 2. Forward this Agreement to the Mayor's Office in accordance with Mayor's Executive Directive No. 3 (Villaraigosa series).

## **FISCAL IMPACT**

The proposed draft agreement provides an amount not to exceed \$155,739.37. The funding will come from the following 3040 accounts:

- E-Commerce (CUPA) \$60,000 Acct: 003040-099, Unit: 4004, WO: FD500001,
   Task: EXPS, SubTask: GENA.
- Fire Marshal's Office Professional Services \$30,000 Acct: 003040-090, Unit: 4003, WO: FD600003, Task: EXPS, SubTask: GENA, and Hazardous Materials Program Technical Assistance \$38,550 Acct: 003040-100, Unit: 4004, WO: FD500001, Task: EXPS, SubTask: GENA.
- The \$27,189.37 balance will come from the Administrative Services Bureau's 3040 account.
