SUMMARY

The information in this report outlines fourth quarter, October 1 through December 31, 2015, fire prevention activities for the Fire Prevention Bureau (FPB) sections as it relates to Fire Prevention inspection activity. The report shows a comparison of the four quarters of the year and sets goals that are measurable.

Additionally, the Department is reporting for the first time all Fire Prevention activity for each of the operational bureaus. This format paints the entire picture of Fire Prevention inspections city-wide and shows our productivity.

DISCUSSION

By utilizing a weekly and monthly FireStat process, we have transitioned into a data driven Bureau, capturing and tracking efficiency levels down to daily activity and success of our members. These actions have provided the Fire Prevention Bureau and Emergency Operations with the ability to plan, organize, and project fire prevention metrics on a weekly, monthly, quarterly, and annual basis.
