- › 105% increase in users with CPR alerts enabled



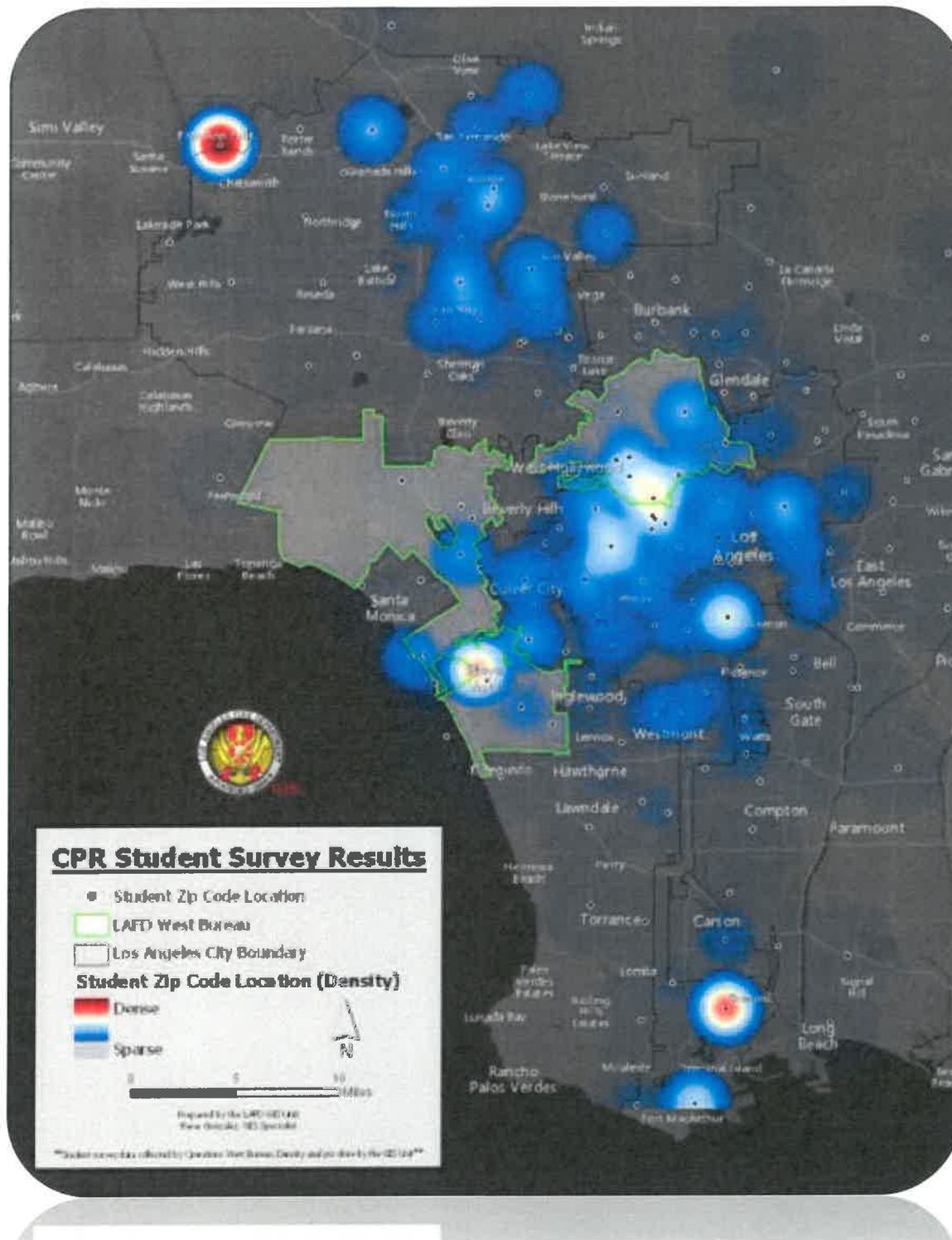
