## SUMMARY

The Los Angeles Fire Department (LAFD), Fire Station 76 is submitting a grant request form in the amount of \$562.68 to purchase a chain link fence privacy screening and hardware to enclose the north parking lot. The privacy equipment will help keep Rescue 76 secure from the increase in foot traffic to that area.

Submitted in accordance with the Los Angeles Administrative Code, Article 12, Sections 5.111.3 and 5.111.4, which provides for the receipt of gifts and bequests of personal property to be utilized by the Fire Department, not exceeding \$5000.00 in market value shall be submitted to the Board of Fire Commissioners for acceptance or rejection.

## RECOMMENDATION

That the Board:

Approve this report and accept the donation from the First-In Fire Foundation, for the items listed above, valued at \$562.68.00 to the Los Angeles Fire Department.

## FISCAL IMPACT

There is no fiscal impact to the Department's budget from the acceptance of this donation. Donations provide the necessary items meeting the needs of the respective fire stations or administration sections. Replacement or repair of items meeting City specifications and Fire Department business needs may be borne by General Fund, subject to budgetary constraints.

## SUMMARY

The members of Fire Station 76 respectfully request approval to utilize donated funds to purchase chain link fence privacy screening and hardware to enclose the North parking lot. The funds are being held by the First-in Fire Foundation.

## RECOMMENDATION

That approval be granted for the release of \$562.68 payable to "Fencescreen.com" from the First-in Fire Foundation for the purchase of the privacy screening.

## FINDINGS

The North parking lot at Fire Station 76 is where Rescue 76 is housed, members park their private and department issued vehicles. Currently there is only chain link fencing surrounding the parking lot, offering no privacy. The parking lot faces the 101 freeway and Cahuenga Blvd. and receives a fair amount of foot traffic and a high amount of vehicle traffic throughout the day. On multiple occasions, we have had individuals peering through the fence, only to run off when questioned. We feel that the privacy screening, which offers almost 100% visible blockage, would be a good theft deterrent.

This product is the highest quality screening available, commonly used on tennis courts, and would also add to the beautification of Fire Station 76. The product would be cut to the premeasured sizes given to the vendor. The color is midnight green, please see the sample included. This product will be self-installed by members at the fire station with experience in fence screen installation.

We have requested this screening through Fire Facilities for both FY19 and FY20. At this time, the department does not have the funds for this project, and is not projected to have it available for FY21.

#### CONCLUSION


