#### SUMMARY

The Los Angeles Fire Department Foundation (LAFDF) and vendor Aventon Bikes, have graciously donated four E-Bikes and four spare batteries to the Los Angeles Fire Department (LAFD) for use by the Bike Team. The LAFD Bike Team is a multi-functional unit that deploys to special events around the City, while also providing regular EMS service to LAX and Venice Beach. The E-Bike donation will allow LAFD Bike Team members the opportunity to use these technologically-advanced models to provide rapid response to EMS calls for service. The value of this donation is estimated at \$8,400,00.

## RECOMMENDATIONS

- Receive this report for the In-Kind Donation by the Los Angeles Fire Department Foundation for the items listed above, valued at \$8,400.00 to the Los Angeles Fire Department.
