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SUMMARY

The Los Angeles Fire Department Foundation (LAFDF) graciously took delivery of a 2021 Toyota Sienna mini-van. The vehicle was donated by Longo Toyota to assist with COVID operations during the pandemic as the Department began administering vaccinations. Since March of 2020, the Los Angeles City Fire Department (LAFD) has provided COVID testing to our city family and residents. To date, LAFD members have conducted more than 4.7 million tests and provided almost 1.5 million vaccinations. The vehicle identification number is 5TDKRKEC2MS058482. The license number is 8XQG889. The value of this donation is \$39,960.01.

RECOMMENDATIONS

That the Board:

- 1. Receive this report for the In-Kind Donation by the Los Angeles Fire Department Foundation for the item listed above, valued at \$39,960.01 to the Los Angeles City Fire Department.
- 2. Request the Commission Executive Assistant to transmit this report to the Mayor's Office in accordance with Executive Directive No. 3 and to City Council in accordance with the Los Angeles Administrative Code, Ordinance 15514, Article 12, Section 5.111.4, for consideration and approval.

FISCAL IMPACT

The 2021 Toyota Sienna Van includes a 2-year 25,000 mile multi-point vehicle maintenance and inspection; a 3-year, 36,000 mile bumper to bumper warranty, and a 5-year, 60,000 mile power train warranty. The multi vehicle maintenance plan and warranty will create minimal fiscal impact to the Supply and Maintenance Division of the Fire Department.

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Donations provide the necessary items meeting the needs of the respective fire stations or administration sections. Replacement or repair of items meeting City specifications and Fire Department business needs may be borne by General Fund, subject to budgetary constraints.

CONCLUSION

Acceptance of this donation will place a new vehicle in the fleet of the LAFD, while eliminating a drawdown of \$39,460.01 on the MICLA account.

The Los Angeles Fire Department benefits tremendously from gracious donations and support provided by the LAFD Foundation. The LAFD acknowledges the LAFDF for its generosity.
