SUMMARY

As requested by the LAFD Board of Fire Commissioners (Commission), the Fire Department is providing a status update relative to the development and implementation of a third-party Training Academy Validation Study.

This report is prepared in compliance with that direction and is provided as a progress report on the project.

DISCUSSION

On September 21 2021, the Commission asked for a report on the feasibility of a third-party analysis/validation study to look at our processes and potential for disparate impacts. The Training and Support Bureau (TSB) welcomes the study as it has been several years since a third-party study has been conducted. As such, the Training Division has reached out to third party consultants under contract to get an estimate of cost for an in-depth study. At this time, the Department is writing a Request for Proposal to go out to bid for a holistic view of the Training Academy.

TSB is currently looking at options for a funding source for a large-scale study. A professional study will be used to assess our successes and aid in developing plans for continual improvement.
