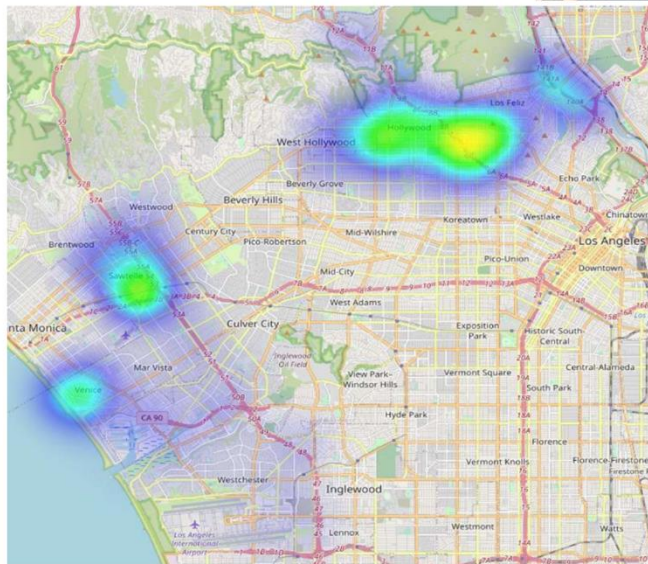

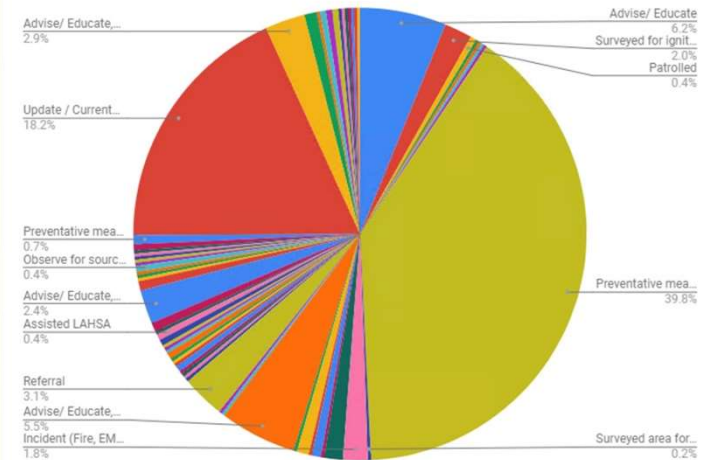

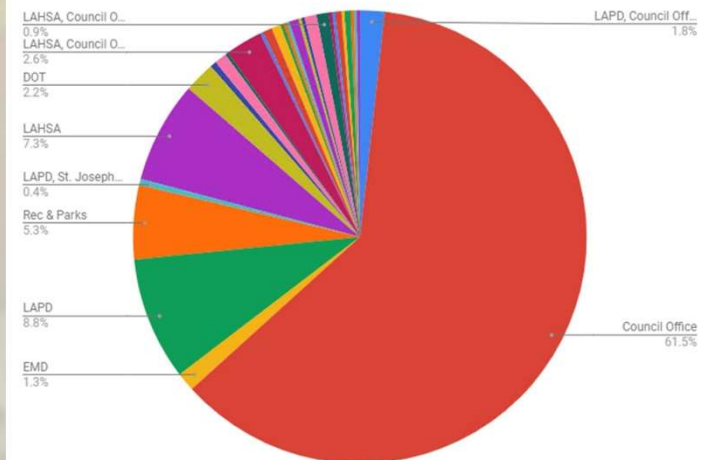

Engages partners (City Council, HOA, NCs, etc.) to be aware of roles and responsibilities related to wildfire preparedness.

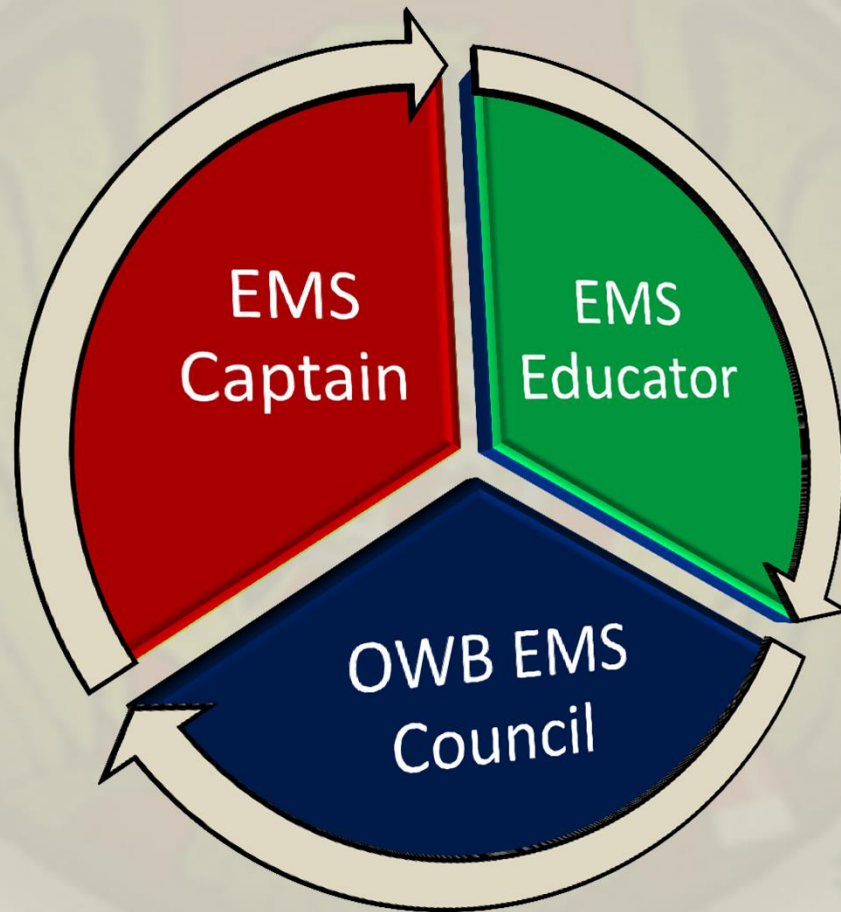


Results
