SUMMARY

Attached for the Board of Fire Commissioners' review is the spreadsheet detailing the Fire Helicopter Pilots and Flight Crews current certifications.

RECOMMENDATION

That the Board: Receive and file.

DISCUSSION

The LAFD Fire Helicopter Pilots are required to maintain:

- FAA Commercial Rotorcraft Pilots license
- FAA Certified Flight Instructor (CFI) rating
- FAA second class medical

The majority of the Pilots assigned to the Air Operations Section far exceed the LAFD's minimum requirements and in addition hold the following FAA licenses:

- Airline Transportation Pilot (ATP) license
- Instrument license
- Certified Flight Instrument Instructor (CFII) license

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Of note, the FAA's ATP license and CFI ratings are the highest certification that the FAA issues. LAFD Pilots are also held to ATP standards annually during their mandated FAA Instrument Pilot Check Rides.

The attached (page 3) provides a comprehensive spreadsheet that details each of the Pilots certifications and flight hours. This spreadsheet is contained in the Department of Health Services (DHS) form 418.1, in which the LAFD is required to submit to DHS annually in accordance with the Air Ambulance provider audit.
