SUMMARY

The Los Angeles Fire Department Foundation (LAFDF) has graciously donated to the Los Angeles City Fire Department (LAFD) a one-year subscription for the Cordico Wellness App including twenty-five (25) individual subscriptions for online peer support training. This app supplements existing health and wellness services and will be available to all sworn and civilian members, their families, and retirees. The value of this donation is estimated at \$99,000.00.

1. Receive this report for the In-Kind Donation by the Los Angeles Fire Department Foundation for the items listed above, valued at \$99,000.00 to the Los Angeles City Fire Department.

FISCAL IMPACT

Donations provide the necessary items meeting the needs of the respective fire stations or administration sections. Replacement or repair of items meeting City specifications and Fire Department business needs may be borne by General Fund, subject to budgetary constraints.
