## **SUMMARY**

At its meeting of April 4, 2006, the Board requested that Department staff provide a written report listing the "Three Whole Scores" failures from the past.

## **FINDINGS**

Staff from the Administrative Services Bureau, Personnel Services Section, reviewed the results from the most recent test administrations dating back to 2002. Members who were bypassed during the process failed to obtain a minimum passing score of 70 percent during the certification interviews. The attached table reflects the results of that review.

## CONCLUSION

During the past four years, there have been seven civil service test administrations in four classifications represented by United Firefighters Los Angeles City (UFLAC). A total of 389 employees have participated in the internal three whole score process, and of those, 37 employees have failed the certification process.
