- 1. Accept an in-kind donation from the Firemens Fund Heritage Program, sponsored by the Swett and Crawford Professional Services Group, valued at approximately \$10,000.
- 2. Accept an in-kind donation from the Venice Beach Rotary Club valued at \$2,659.00
- 3. Instruct the Commission Executive Assistant II to forward this report for necessary action to the Mayor's Office in accordance with Executive Directive No. 3 and the City Council in accordance with the Los Angeles Administrative Code Article 12.

Summary.

The total cost for these lockers is \$12,659. The Swett and Crawford Professional Services Group, through the Firemens Fund Heritage Program, has donated a total of \$10,000 towards the purchase of Wall Mount Lockers for Fire Station 63. The Venice Beach Rotary Club has raised a total of \$2,659 to donate towards the cost of these lockers. There will be a total of 36 lockers, 24 to be attached to the west wall and 12 to be attached to the center of the apparatus floor. These lockers will greatly improve the appearance of the station and will also provide for the security and drying of turnout equipment on the apparatus floor.

The total cost of these lockers is approximately \$12,659.00. The vendor is Grear Grid and will be compensated directly through the Firemens Heritage Fund. This project has been cleared through the Building Administration Section and was approved by the Department of General Services.

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Conclusion:

The members of Fire Station 63 are very grateful to the Firemens Heritage Fund, the Swett and Crawford Professional Services Group and the Venice Beach Rotary Club for their generosity and support of the members of Fire Station 63.

SUMMARY

Fire Station 63 was approached by the Fireman's Fund Insurance Co. to accept a donation of \$10,000.00 towards wall mount lockers. The Venice Beach Rotary Club would like to doante the additional money needed as an in-kind donartion for a total of \$12,659.00. This donation will greatly improve the appearance and provide for the security and drying of turnout equipment through installing wall mount turnout lockers to the fire station.

RECOMMENDATION

We respectfully recommend that approval be granted for Fire Station 63 to accept an in-kind donation and allow the installation of wall mouont lockers to the fire station.

FINDINGS

Swett and Crawford Professional Services Group has graciously directed a donation as part of the Fireman's Fund Heritage program in the amount of \$10,000.00 dollars to Fire Station 63 for wall mount turnout lockers.

The Rotary club adopted Fire Station 63 in 2005 to help renovate the Fire Station. Through a fundraiser, the Venice Beach Rotary Club has raised funds for in-kind donations to provide the additional monies (\$2659.00) needed for wall mount lockers for turnout equipment against the North wall of FS 63.

Total amount ordered: 36 lockers. 24 to be attached to the North wall and 12 to be attached to the center of the apparatus floor. The wall mount lockers against the North wall will have locking doors attached while the apparatus floor lockers will remain open. Dimensions: 20" x 20" x 74.5".
