Summary.

This request is made in accordance with Article 12, Section 5.111.4 of the Administrative Code, which gives the Board of Fire Commissioners authority to accept in-kind donations to the Fire Department valued under \$5,000.

Fire Station 88 is coordinating the building of a kennel for the FEMA CA-TF1 Search and Rescue (SAR) canines. Currently, there is a stand-alone 10'x5' kennel located on a dirt patch with no sun protection. The plans to improve this area include a pea-gravel base, chain link gates at each end, solid overhead protection from both sun and debris and a misting system. The improved kennel will be used on a regular basis by the SAR canine owned by FF Margaret Steward, 88 "B". Additionally, it will provide a safe and secure storage area for all FEMA canines during deployment mobilization, exercises and training.
