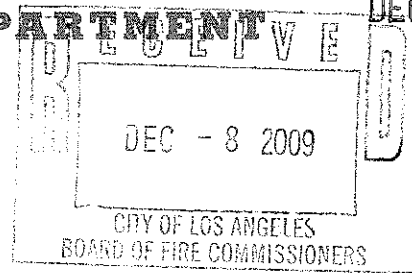

Recommendation: That the Board:

1. Accept a donation of an Ice Machine valued at approximately \$3500, from Toyota, U.S.A., which is headquartered in Carson, California, in accordance with Article 12 of the Los Angeles Administrative Code.

Summary.

Toyota U.S.A. has generously offered to donate an ice machine to Fire Station 11. The ice machine is manufactured by ICE O MATIC and is valued at approximately \$3500. Ice machines at the fire station have long been beneficial to all members of the LAFD. A parking lot adjacent to FS 11 is commonly used as a staging and/or command post for large-scale incidents. During these incidents, all involved agencies will benefit from the use of this ice machine.

Fiscal Impact:

The LAFD will not incur any costs by accepting this donation. All costs for repairs and maintenance will be handled through the station's house dues account.

Conclusion:

The Fire Department is fortunate to be the recipient of donations such as this one and would like to acknowledge Toyota U.S.A. for their generous donation.

It is respectfully recommended that:

- The Los Angeles Fire Department accept the donated Ice machine at Fire Station 11.

FINDINGS

- An Ice machine was donated to Fire Station 11 by Toyota U.S.A. headquartered in Carson, California.
- The Ice machine is manufactured by ICE O MATIC.
- Cost of Ice machine (when new) was approximately \$3,500.00
- Serial #A000-01145-Z
- Model #E40PSA
- Members use the ice for the daily benefit of assigned personnel.
- A large parking lot adjacent to Fire Station 11 is commonly used as a staging and/or command post for large-scale Incidents. During these incidents, all involved agencies use the Ice machine for their members.
- Fire Station 11 is the closest alternate resource for Battalion 11 to fill their ice-chests for Department supplied water and Gatorade.
