- 2. Accept a donation of \$20,540.62 for community outreach and training and direct the Controller to deposit funds these funds into Fund 848, Fire Department Trust Fund, account number to be determined later.
- 3. Instruct the Commission Executive Assistant II to forward this report for necessary action to the Mayor's Office in accordance with Executive Directive No. 3 and the City Council in accordance with the Los Angeles Administrative Code Article 12.

Summary.

Allianz Life and Firemen's Fund Insurance award millions of dollars in grants each year to fire departments and fire and burn prevention organizations for needed equipment, training and community education programs.

Disaster Preparedness was selected by Allianz Life and Firemen's Fund Insurance to receive this in-kind donation totaling \$41,432.38 (list attached), as well as a monetary donation totaling \$20,540.62 to be used for community outreach and training, for a total donation of \$61,973.

Funds for these products are provided from the Heritage Program directly to the vendors, who have supplied their Federal Tax Identification to Fireman's Fund and Allianz. The products will then be donated in-kind to our Disaster Preparedness Section.

The Department's Management Information System has been involved in the process and has ensured that all technology-related equipment is consistent with and compatible with the Department's existing applications and needs. All specifications for desktop and laptop systems were provided and reviewed for approval.

Fiscal Impact

All of these technology-related items are replacing existing, outdated and incompatible systems and will not add any additional maintenance and/or repair costs to the City. All supply items related to community outreach and survival products are a one-time purchase and if necessary, will be replaced using funds deposited into Fund 848.

There is one stand-alone Desktop System that will be proprietary to the CERT Unit. This is a special computer with high-speed capacity, special printing software, a very large data base capacity and a much larger hard drive. This computer will not be hooked into the Fire Department Network and will not be maintained by the City. Therefore, there will be no cost associated with the maintenance or repair of this item.

Conclusion:

The benefits of this program are numerous. CERT has increased the overall level of public disaster readiness in Los Angeles, provided emergency skills that people may use in day-to-day emergencies, enhanced the bond between government and populace, and increased community spirit.

SUMMARY

Swett & Crawford Insurance Company of Los Angeles directed a public safety and education grant to our Community Emergency Response Team (CERT) Program. During the month of October a grant application was submitted on behalf of the CERT Program to the Heritage Program sponsored by Allianz and Fireman's Fund Insurance. The grant has been approved where Allianz Life and Fireman's Fund are donating approximately **\$61,973** in equipment and supplies to our CERT Program.

RECOMMENDATION

It is respectfully recommended that the Disaster Preparedness Section and CERT Unit be given approval to receive the donations of equipment as outlined in the information below.

FINDINGS

Allianz Life and Fireman's Fund Insurance award millions of dollars in grants each year to fire departments and fire and burn prevention organizations for needed equipment, training and community education programs.

Grants are awarded by their employees through a nomination process, or by agents who offer their products and are able to direct grants to a given organization. Swett & Crawford Insurance directed the grant monies in question to our Disaster Preparedness efforts and the CERT Program.

We coordinated with representatives of Allianz and Fireman's Fund to clarify the parameters of the grant. An application was provided and all donated items from this grant will be utilized for our Disaster Preparedness efforts, community outreach and education in Los Angeles, and the CERT Program delivery.

The following items will be purchased by, then provided by Allianz Life and Fireman's Fund Insurance as in-kind donations as part of this grant process.

Audio visual training equipment (computers, projectors, printers and television monitors) for the Community Emergency Response Training (CERT) Program and Emergency Management staff. The eight (8) full-time CERT instructors utilize laptop computers and projectors for education and program delivery. The current equipment is outdated and unreliable, and all eight packages will be replaced with new Dell computers.

The primary CERT Unit Secretary has been without a desktop computer for several months. She is responsible for the volunteer database, documentation and all credentialing associated with the program – so her system is being completely updated. The Captain II and Captain I have been using Sony computers that were donated several years ago. The desktop systems for the Battalion Chief, the Captain II, and the Captain I in charge of overseeing the CERT program are also being replaced.

Additionally, an all terrain vehicle is being donated for use during training evolutions for our CERT response volunteers in transporting equipment (mannequins, extinguishers, shoring, rehab, etc) and also during actual deployments for management of volunteer personnel at large disaster training events, brush fires and other large scale emergencies. The vehicle will be stored and transported in the enclosed CERT trailer currently out for bid.

Several CERT labeled EZ-UP shade canopies and table covers for our community outreach and training events, along with a large amount of outreach disaster related materials and literature is being donated.

Funds for these products are provided from the Heritage Program directly to the vendors, who have supplied their Federal Tax Identification to Fireman's Fund and Allianz. The products will then be donated to our Disaster Preparedness Section.

DISCUSSION

We have communicated with MIS staff regarding the donated Dell computer equipment to ensure compatibility with our Department's applications and needs. Specifications for the desktop and laptop systems were provided and reviewed for approval.
